Admission Requirements 2019 - 2020

All Parents/Guardians must complete the following as part of the registration process:

- A registration form and registration fee paid for each child attending Saint Gabriel Catholic School
- A completed FACTS Tuition Management Form (one per family)
- A Tuition Contract signed and dated (one per family)

In addition to the completed forms indicated above, parents/guardians of students NEW to Saint Gabriel Catholic School must provide the following documents:

- Copy of Birth Certificate (Due at registration)
- Copy of Baptismal Certificate if not baptized at Saint Gabriel Catholic Church (Due at registration)
- Request For Cumulative Records Form (First grade through Eighth grade)
- Copy of the child's health record, including the most current physical exam, immunizations record, dental exam and eye exam (see specific grade level requirements below) (Due at registration)

Preschool: Entering New or Reregistering

- Child must be three years old as of September 1, 2019
- A complete physical exam by a physician dated 2019 and up-to-date immunizations reported on forms prescribed by the Illinois Department of Public Health must be completed prior to entering school

Kindergarten: Entering New or Re-Registering:

- A child must be five years old no later than September 1, 2019.
- A complete physical exam dated 2019 and a record of up-to-date immunizations reported on forms prescribed by the Illinois Department of Public Health must be completed prior to entering school
- An eye exam dated 2019 is due before October 15, 2019.
- A dental exam dated 2019/2020 is due before May 15, 2020.

Second Grade: Entering New or Re-Registering

- A dental exam dated 2019/2020 recorded on forms prescribed by the Illinois Department of Public Health is due before May 15, 2020.

Sixth Grade: Entering New or Re-Registering

- A physical exam and up-to-date immunizations dated 2019 recorded on forms prescribed by the Illinois Department of Public Health are due before October 15, 2019.
- A dental exam dated 2019/2020 is due before May 15, 2020.
